Consolidate Balances of Balance Sheet Accounts

Product: Finacle Core Banking Version: 10.2.18 onwards

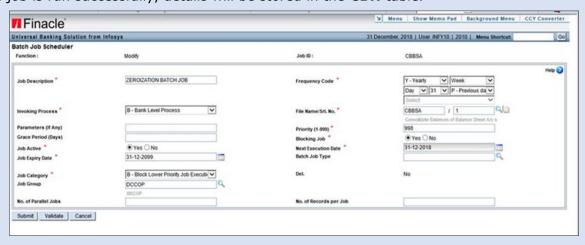
Consolidate Balances of Balance Sheet Accounts (CBBSA) is a batch menu option used for consolidating the income/ expense balances at the bank level or **SOL** level, in any currency. This is a product batch job developed for P&L zeroization which occurs during **EOY**. Here are the steps to follow to enable this option:

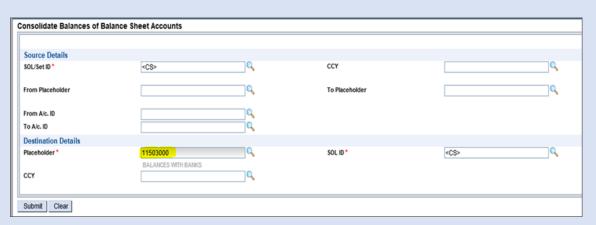
Identify the list of office accounts in the **HACMDB** menu for which the zeroization batch job must be run. Change the "**Consolidate Balance**" flag to "**Yes**" for the above-identified accounts. Zeroization batch job **(CBBSA)** will consider only those accounts whose consolidate balance flag is "**Yes**". The corresponding backend table is **GAM** and the column is cons_bal_flg



- Identify the placeholder or office accounts where the balance of the above-listed accounts will be consolidated
- Complete the below batch job setup in the **HBJSTM** menu and replicate it for all **SOLs**. It should be part of the **HBKCOP** menu so that **CBBSA** will run and execute transactions for the financial year-end

Once the batch job is run successfully, details will be stored in the **CBH** table.





Significance of Blocking Job and Job Category in HBJSTM

Finacle Core Banking Version: 10.2.x onwards

This article will explain the significance of Blocking Job and Job Category parameters in detail.

Blocking Job:

During the **EODBOD**, if the bank doesn't want to progress further in case of the failure of any critical jobs, the bank can mark that batch job as **Blocking** in the scheduler. This way if the job is not successfully executed then **EODBOD** is aborted. This will also ensure that the next execution date of the batch job gets changed as per the frequency maintained for the job only when the job is executed successfully.

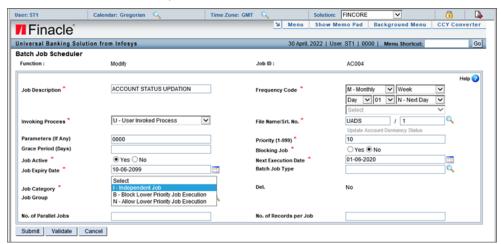
Job Category:

The job category helps in deciding the sequence of batch job execution when jobs are ordered based on priority number, with 1 being the first and 999 being the last to be executed.

The possible values are:

- **Independent Job**: This implies that the job is independent, and it can be executed whenever CPU resources are available irrespective of other jobs having priority before or after this job
- Allow Lower priority Job Execution: It is similar to Independent. However, the jobs having a priority lower
 than this job are allowed to execute
- **Block Lower priority Job Execution**: It implies that jobs are expected to follow sequential execution. Jobs having a priority higher than this job and of the same category type will be executed prior to this job and jobs having a priority lower than this job of the same category type will be executed after the completion of this job
