## **Performance Improvement in CSIS Transmit Service**

**Product: Finacle Connect 24 Version: 10.2.x** 

This **TABLES\_NOT\_RQD** env variables used in Transmit Config service to enhance refresh rate to **CSIS** Database.

For example, **TABLES\_NOT\_RQD** = '**AAC**', '**HOL**', '**MMSG**' can be set. This will enable deletion of records in **SOD** table pertaining to the tables **AAC**, **HOL** and **MMSG** without transmitting it to the **CSIS** database.

The following are the indicative list of tables which need not be transmitted to **CSIS** database when **FAB** is not configured:

AAC, AAS, AMT, BCT, BKC, CRC, CTC, DDS, DST, GEC, GET, GSH, MMSG, GSS, HIT, HOL.

Banks may choose to configure the list as per their business scenario of how CSIS is being used.

## **Transaction Amount Range Configuration Specific to Payment Network**

**Product: Finacle Online Banking Version: 11.0.x and 11.2.x** 


In Finacle Online Banking, there is an option to configure the minimum and maximum transaction amount range specific to payment networks. When user initiates the transaction, framework will validate the transaction amount against the amount range configured for the corresponding network.

This configuration is stored in **NPRT** (NETWORK PROPERTIES TABLE) table and below the details of the admin use case to configure the transaction amount range for the network.

Navigation in admin application:

For version **11.2.x** Transaction Administration: Financial Transaction Maintenance > Network Properties For version **11.0.x** Application Maintenance: Financial Transaction Maintenance > Network Properties

#### Screenshot of 11.2.x version



End users will observe an exception as 'Enter the valid amount supported by the network' when a transaction beyond the defined range of the respective network is initiated.

These fields are non-mandatory fields and if kept blank those fields will be updated as 0.00 and in that case the transaction amount validation will be skipped for the network through which that transaction initiated.
